Angel's Quest provides a warm, safe, caring atmosphere

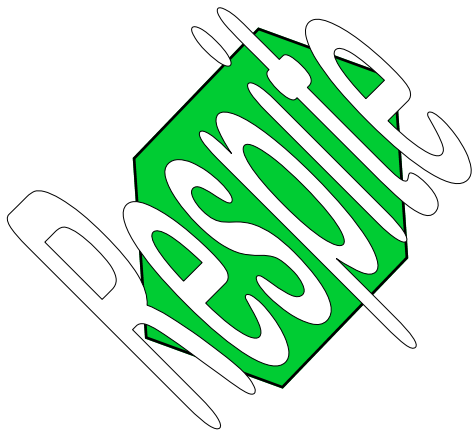
It is available for day, overnight and crisis care.

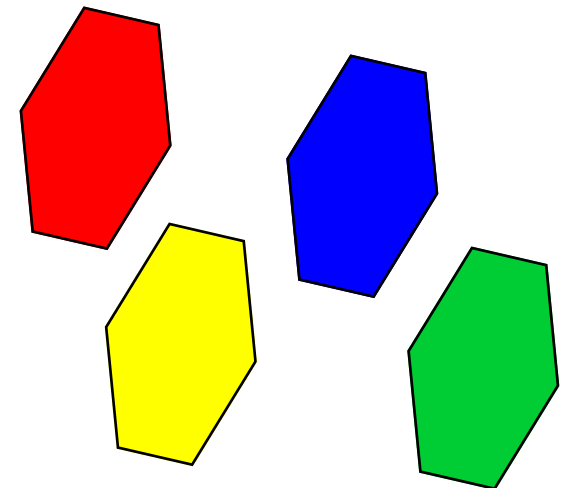

1st Step Programme
0-2½ year olds
Kildarton

Provides information, guidance, counselling and support to families through the early years of baby's development. Families may avail of a number of different options as appropriate. A home based service, a centre based service or combined home based and centre based.

The Service Provides:

- ☺ Contact with Social Worker, who provides information and counselling.
- ☺ 1st Step Meeting; an introduction to Early Services Team.
- ☺ Once weekly session for babies and parents
- ☺ A Portage Home Visitor will visit the child in his/her own home, and in conjunction with family will work toward identifying and attaining specific goals.
- ☺ Early Services Team, which comprises of social worker, O. T., psychologist, physiotherapist, speech and language therapist, teacher and nurse, will offer support and guidance as required.

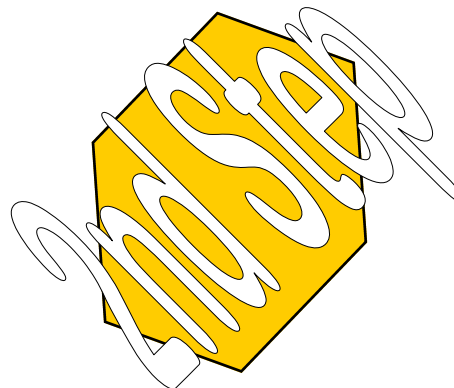
2nd Step Programme
2½-5 year olds
Kildarton

Early Development Programme, which provides a holistic approach to early childhood development.

The Service Provides:

- ☺ Sessions of up to four mornings per week, where each child has a person centred plan to help him/her reach their full potential.
- ☺ Staff parent meetings.
- ☺ Support to child or family in mainstream setting.
- ☺ Multi-disciplinary team support continues from social worker, psychologist, physiotherapist, occupational therapist, speech and language therapist, teacher and nurse, as required.
- ☺ Support and guidance in planning future requirements.

3-18 year olds
